PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITIES

Christian Hamann, Chemistry & Biochemistry, was accorded a sabbatical research fellowship, starting January 2008. He will be studying molecular motion using computational methods in the laboratory of Professor Dean Tantillo (Department of Chemistry, University of California – Davis).

Susan M. Hughes, Psychology, published “Sex Differences in Romantic Kissing among College Students: An Evolutionary Perspective” in the August issue of *Evolutionary Psychology* with her co-authors M. Harrison and G. Gallup. The article has garnered international interest including features on BBC, in the *London Times*, *Chicago Sun* and *Science Daily*.

Richard Hamwi, Art, had a watercolor collage accepted for inclusion in the Lancaster County Art Association Juried Exhibition, June 10 through July 21, 2007. The juror was William Zimmer, Art Critic for the *New York Times*. He has also had a pen and ink drawing accepted for inclusion in the Hoyt Mid-Atlantic Juried Art Exhibition which will be shown at the Hoyt Art Institute in New Castle, Pennsylvania, October 2 through November 21, 2007.

John Incledon, Modern Foreign Languages & Literature, participated in a two-week seminar in June at Northwestern University on the Holocaust and Jewish Civilization. His article on “Incest and Revolution: Analysis of One Line from Fernando de Fuentes’s *Doña Bárbara*” was recently accepted for publication in *Cine-Lit VI*. On July 28 he gave a talk at Keshet Zion Synagogue on “New Issues in Holocaust Studies.”

Jeffrey Lentz, Theatre and Music, recently performed the role of Heurtebise in a production of Philip Glass' opera, ORPHEE (based on the 1949 film by Jean Cocteau) at the Glimmerglass Opera Festival in Cooperstown, NY. New York Times music critic, Anthony Thomassini described Jeffrey's work in the opera as "nuanced and commanding". The critically acclaimed production, conducted by Anne Manson, is scheduled to play at Lincoln Center's New York City Opera and other regional venues in the coming seasons. While in residence at Glimmerglass, Jeffrey mentored 28 members of Glimmerglass' Young American Artists Program during several master classes in acting and auditioning techniques.

Julia Matthews, Theatre, participated as a creator and performer in the "Re-Actions Project" at the New Orleans national conference of the Association for Theatre in Higher Education in July 2007. Julia has recently been elected to the board of directors of the Berks Arts Council.

- 56 binders submitted (Total faculty eligible for submission = 102)

- 94 faculty received the satisfactory raise of 4.6% (administrative/staff percentage = 3%)
